TITLE OF POSITION: Food Recovery Volunteer

LOCATION/PROGRAM: The Centre of Hope, Community and Family Services

DESCRIPTION OF ASSIGNMENT: Come cook with us and have a gastronomically good time! Work under the guidance of the Food Recovery Program Coordinator, to turn recovered food into delicious meals to be distributed throughout our food bank. Prepare, cook and package meals to reduce food waste and feed Londoners today!

SPECIFIC DUTIES:

- Preparing and cooking meals
- Package and label meals
- Other duties as requested by the Food Recovery Program Coordinator

QUALIFICATIONS:

Volunteer must be at least 18 years old, with exceptions at the sole discretion of The Salvation Army. Volunteers must have cooking experience. No Police Check is required.

SCHEDULE: This position is on an on-call basis depending on food bank needs – ideally on Fridays. When volunteers are required it will be for a minimum of 2 hours weekly, March – September.

LENGTH OF COMMITMENT NECESSARY: March - September

STAFF SUPERVISOR: Food Recovery Program Coordinator

STARTING DATE: March 27, 2020

DEADLINE TO APPLY: MARCH 20, 2020

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Must provide own transportation
- Must be able to work independently, with other volunteers and the public
- No open-toed shoes/sandals/flip-flops
- Proper safe food handling and personal hygiene policies must be followed
- Punctuality, attention to detail, cooperativeness and adherence to all policies and safety guidelines are imperative
- Confidentiality expected
